Group promotion is essential to a successful single mom support group. In this guide, we will give some tips and pointers on how to effectively promote your group! Let's go! Contact us with questions!



Design an image that includes your groups information such as date, times, location, etc that can be added to your social media channels, your church announcement slides, your church bulletin, etc.


## **Facebook**



\*\*\*Childcare will be provided for all ages during each group meeting.


You do not have to be a member of Liberty Baptist Church to attend, all single moms are invited!


After your event is created, you can "Boost" it to a targeted crowd. To get started Click "Boost Event."




Click "Create new" to create a custom audience focused on single moms in the areas around your church.




Enter your meeting location address in search bar and choose 5 to 10 miles or whatever distance you desire.



Before clicking "Save Audience" scroll down to "Detailed Targeting" and click "Browse"




Selection the "Relationship" drop down menu.




Under Relationship, select relationship statuses related to single moms, including divorced, separated, single, and widowed. You can also try out civil union, complicated, domestic partnerships, open relationships, unspecified, or even in a relationship because these statuses could relate to a single mom as well.


After selecting click the arrow to go back.



Now the relationship statuses that you selected should show in blue under the "Detailed targeting" section. Confirm that everything looks the way you want it to for your new audience and then click "Save Audience."



Scroll down to the bottom of the ad and select your duration and the total budget. It often takes 12-48 hours to get a boost approved by Facebook. It is recommended to start boosting your post 3-5 days before your event. When you are done click "Boost Post Now."



After you click Boost event now it will display as Under Review and it Facebook should give you a notification when your ad begins to run. If you make any changes to your ad after it is approved it usually goes into under review again and takes time to approve it.
